An EPD is similar to a food nutrition label in that it is a third party verified statement of product ingredients and environmental impacts that happen during the entire life of a product. Recently, the company announced that it is on track to complete EPDs for 100% of its manufactured products, measured by production volume, in the year 2012. EPDs can help facility managers make an objective comparison of environmental attributes and impacts between two products.

Bentley Prince Street has been carrying out its Los Angeles inspired Art, Culture and Fashion theme ever since it launched at [NeoCon](#) 2011. In June, Advanced Fashion Students from [Fashion Institute of Design & Merchandising](#) (FIDM) transformed Bentley Prince Street products into couture dresses.
